It was March 24th. We had finally completed substantial preparations and were on the brink of rolling out our new **Parenting Initiative** program. We would provide patients with mentoring and parenting skills, and in the process of learning they would earn many free baby items such as furniture and clothing.



Then COVID smacked us. Those days were hard on all of us. We adjusted course, and last week we "graduated" our first patient, Tasha*, from the new program!

The Parenting Initiative gives us numerous opportunities to go deeper with our patients. Trained mentors meet weekly with their "mentorees," going over parenting skills for their new little ones. We use an on-line curriculum and utilize a lot of one-on-one interaction.

When we say Tasha graduated, we mean she completed her first six-week module. Our hope is for her to complete many more modules. For her efforts so far she has earned an infant car seat. There is much more she can earn, and she will keep learning in the process. Plus she will have the dignity of not receiving a hand-out but of working to provide for herself and her baby.
